Westside Central Office, an Intergroup for the Westside of Portland, is seeking A.A.s for the following service positions:

(Revised September 12, 2015)

Office Volunteer – Volunteer at our office one Saturday a month between 12noon-4pm. Duties include opening/closing the office, selling A.A. literature, answering the office telephone, and answering questions on A.A. for anyone who stops by the office. 2 or more years of sobriety is suggested. Suggested term is 1 year.

Activities Chair – Leads a committee that holds regular A.A. events sponsored by Westside Central Office. 1 or more years of sobriety is suggested. Serves through September 30, 2016.

Outreach Chair – Leads a committee of volunteers that informs A.A. groups on how to get involved with Westside Central Office. 2 or more years of sobriety is suggested. Serves through September 30, 2016.

Public Information Committee Chair – Leads a committee of volunteers that informs the public on “what A.A. is” and “what A.A. is not”. 2 or more years of sobriety is suggested. Serves through September 30, 2016.

Corrections Committee Chair – Leads a committee that carries A.A.’s message of hope to alcoholics behind bars. 2 or more years of sobriety is suggested. Serves through September 30, 2016.

Treatment Facilities Committee Chair – Leads a committee that carries A.A.’s message of hope into Treatment Facilities. 2 or more years of sobriety is suggested. Serves through September 30, 2016.

12 Step Call Chair – Maintains a list of 12 Step Call Volunteers. 2 or more years of sobriety is suggested. Serves through September 30, 2016.

A.A. Hotline Chair – Seeks volunteers for our hotline and maintains the answering service that forwards calls to volunteers. 2 or more years of sobriety is suggested. Serves through September 30, 2016.

Newsletter Chair – Publishes the Westside Central Office newsletter, *Into Action!* 2 or more years of sobriety is suggested. Serves through September 30, 2016.

Literature Chair – Maintains the stock of A.A. literature at Westside Central Office; purchasing as needed. 2 or more years of sobriety is suggested. Serves through September 30, 2016.

Cooperation with the Professional Community – Informs professionals that come into contact with active alcoholics “what A.A. is” and “what A.A. is not” These professionals include law enforcement, attorneys, teachers, clergy, health care workers, and counselors.
